If we expect that these weights are correct then all of the dogs are underweight at present. Not very good prospect for the coming winter.

This will have to give each dog a portion of a block of whale meat instead of the normal one which we have usually been giving.

20th May (Capitol Day) - Have been out several times with a team of four sled dogs trying up whale meat, raw polar and raw whale blubber. Searched for the upper part which was not available. Found half - frozen,

one - Crystal, Charlie, Sam - Charlie, Brown - field. They
are all now quite well together, although Charlie and
Crystal Brown got 8 eggs with one another in one occasion.
Trid to keep out diseases for one day, but he immediately
attacked everyone we tried to put him with, so that for the
time being we have left him to himself at his pen.

Have been shooting while and on continuous days
now, and have now started with red neck. The gun bladder
was very weak and a bust. In addition has been trying
to take them every day day. Don't know whether it is
due to that but there is a lot more meat now about in things
that I am.

It may be just a wild supposition but the condition
of the dogs seems to be much better than at beginning of
month. Not odd though that we have not weighed them again
yet.

dogs improving, just hardly any news.
Hoping to still improve slightly ???

Sunday 11th July 1933 Quite a lot of water under the bridge




