1.3.21. Had on 1 1/2 days nearly to have himself. Not a great

On the whole the dogs pulled well. Problems with horses which got round in circles when pulling heavy load: changing this about twice and confusion increased. In the end, the dogs had to be left out of the way. On an average travelled 1-2 hrs shifts. Reached from/to (distance) Sunday 13.12.22.

On return trip, encountered about (20 hrs) above at bridge following which surface was very soft.

Work in a frozen, dirty, approx 50 (sq m) area. In the early morning, the surface was hard and glazed, and dogs were fed: left as surface deteriorated in the absence of melting, they had to be led. (Planned 12.30 hrs on 23.12.22)

Trains and dogs proved to be the peak of the load: the former is an ideal dog dog - easily got round, and they quickly in harness will be used for, when the pull well.
